

## Developing WYLLN 14 -19 Diploma Progression Agreements

<p><b>Activity</b></p>	<p>To develop progression agreements, using the WYLLN Progression Agreement Framework, between 14-19 Diploma Level 3 courses and higher education courses within West Yorkshire.</p> <p>The following principles will underpin the development of these particular progression agreements in order to encourage the delivery of a common experience across the sub-region to Diploma learners:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>- multi entry progression, achieved via working across consortia wherever possible</li> </ul> <p>and/or</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>- multi exit progression, achieved via either one receiving institution or two or more receiving institutions</li> </ul>
<p><b>Description of outcomes</b></p>	<p>1. To establish and implement WYLLN progression agreements for learners on 14-19 Diploma level 3 courses which are either currently on offer or will be on offer from September 2009 within West Yorkshire:</p> <p>a) Currently on offer:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Creative and Media</li> <li>• Construction and Built Environment</li> <li>• Society, Health and Development</li> </ul> <p>b) On offer from September 2009:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• IT</li> <li>• Engineering</li> <li>• Business and Finance</li> <li>• Hair and Beauty</li> <li>• Manufacturing and Product Design</li> <li>• Hospitality</li> <li>• Environmental and Land - based Studies</li> </ul> <p>2. To provide details of progression agreements and routes for inclusion in a WYLLN 14-19 Diploma Progression publication aimed at young people, parents and carers.</p>
<p><b>Timescales for the delivery of the outcomes</b></p>	<p>Funding to be made available from June 2009 – March 2010</p> <p>1a. Progression Agreements for Diploma lines currently on offer to be WYLLN recognised and in operation by November 2009.</p> <p>1b. 	<p>September 2009 to be WYLLN recognised and in operation by March 2010.</p> <p>2. Progression route information to be made available for a WYLLN 14-19 Diploma Progression publication by 31<sup>st</sup> March 2010.</p>
<p><b>Process and timescales for allocation of funding</b></p>	<p>8<sup>th</sup> July      HEIs/FECs submit an activity form detailing:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>- the Diploma line(s) a progression agreement is to be developed for</li> <li>- the consortia involved</li> <li>- the number of institutions within each consortia who will be signatories to the progression agreement</li> <li>- the total number of progression agreements to be produced</li> </ul> <p>Mid July      WYLLN agrees proposals and contracts with HEIs/FECs</p>
<p><b>WYLLN Funding</b></p>	<p>Up to £3000 per institution per progression agreement</p> <p>N.B. Payments will be made to WYLLN partners. However, progression agreements which involve non WYLLN partners will also be considered for payment.</p>
